PARISH OF GREASLEY



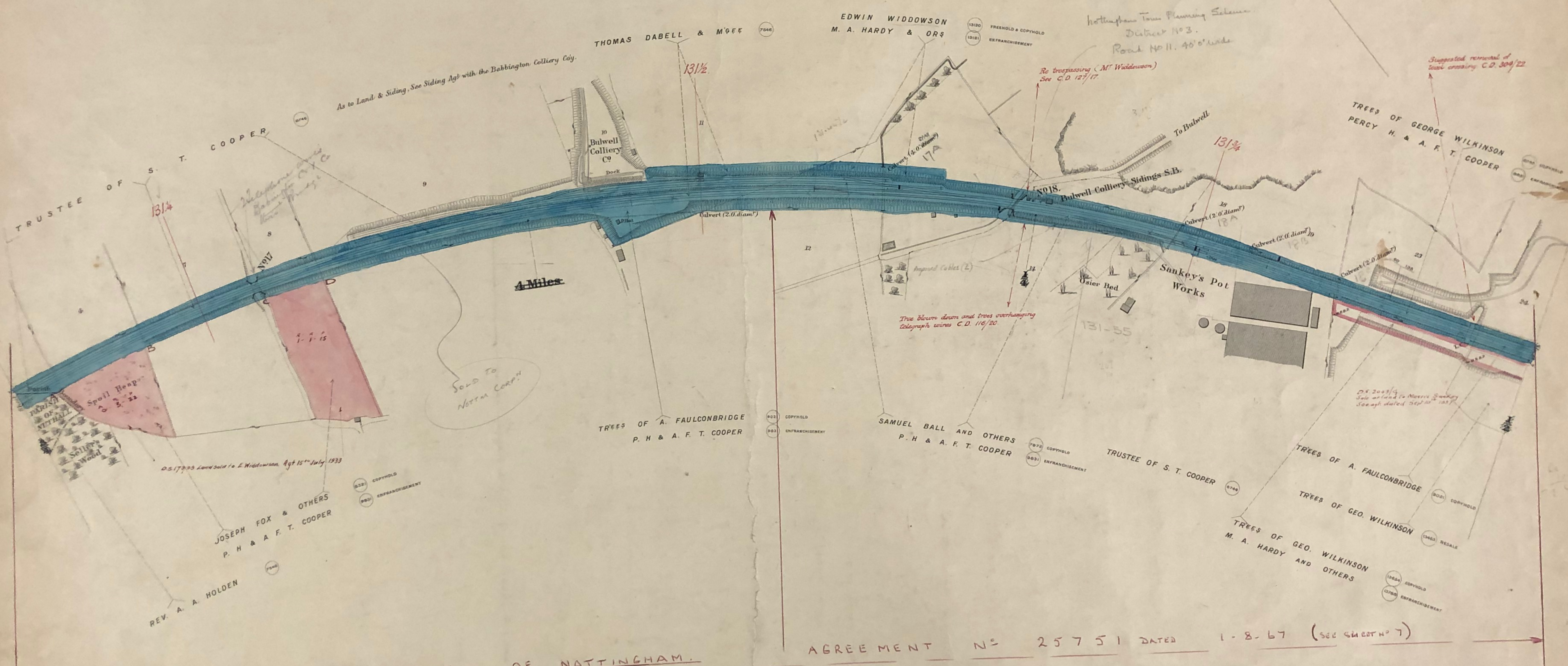
