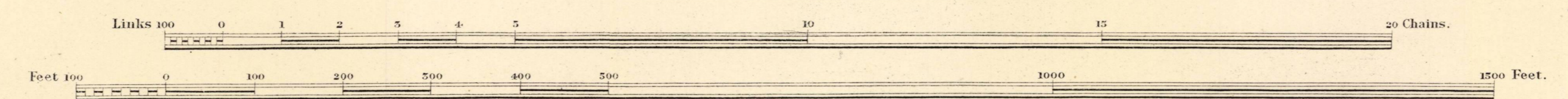


ECCLESIASTICAL TRUSTEES OF THE PARKHURST ESTATES

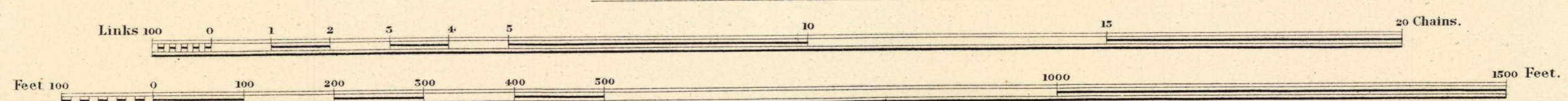
PARISH OF GREAT MALVERN
