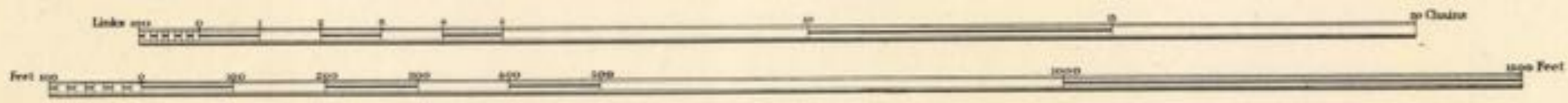
PARISH OF SHORT HEATH
